Who are 'you'?

Service or Game Operators ("**Customer**")

You are the developer of an application or service and choose to build Anti-Cheat Expert into your application or service. We will process limited information to contact you and provide Anti-Cheat Expert.

End Users of Services or Applications that use the Anti-Cheat Expert Software ("**End User**")

You are the End User of an application or service that includes Anti-Cheat Expert. **If you are an End User of a game that includes Anti-Cheat Expert then we are not the data controller for your personal data, we are solely a data processor.** We recommend that you contact the data controller for the relevant game – the details of the data controller should be set out in the privacy policy for the game.

This privacy policy describes matters relating to Customers only.

What information do we need to provide Anti-Cheat Expert?

If you register an account to use Anti-Cheat Expert then we will need some information from you to set this up. We will process some information when you set up a developer arrangement for Anti-Cheat Expert ([e.g.to](#) contact you and determine the data to be processed). please see the section entitled **[The Types of Personal Information We Use]** below.

How will we use your information?

We use your information to provide the functions that comprise Anti-Cheat Expert (including but not limited to providing anti-cheat detection and countermeasures within the product/ service/ game that incorporates the ACE Game Anti-Cheating Feature). We also use your information for account creation, verification and log-in, and to provide you with support and improve Anti-Cheat Expert. We do not share your information with any third parties, except where we need to in order to provide Anti-

Cheat Expert(e.g., use local cloud providers or to back up your data; using our affiliates around the world to help us to deliver Anti-Cheat Expert), or we are instructed to by a court, authority or compelled by law. please see the section entitled **[How We Use Your Personal Information]** below.

Who do we share your information with?

We use some third parties to help us deliver the best possible experience (e.g., cloud services to back up your data). When we use a third party, we only do this to process or store your information for the purposes described in this privacy policy. We have affiliates around the world who help us deliver Anti-Cheat Expert and we may be required by a court or legal obligation to disclose certain information in some circumstances.

Where do we process your information?

Our servers are located in Singapore. Our support, engineering and other teams are located in Singapore and will have access to your information.

How long do we keep hold of your information?

We generally retain your information for the period during which you maintain an account for Anti-Cheat Expert, after which time your data is deleted (as further described in this privacy policy), unless otherwise required by applicable laws. please see the section entitled **[Data Retention]** below.

This privacy policy explains the when, how and why when it comes to processing of your personal information in connection with Anti-Cheat Expert ("**Anti-Cheat Expert**"), and sets out the choices and rights in relation to that information. Please read it carefully – it is important for you to understand how we collect and use your information and how you, whether as a Customer or End User can control it.

If you are a Customer and do not agree to the processing of your personal information in the way this privacy policy describes, please do not provide your information when requested and stop using Anti-Cheat Expert. By using Anti-Cheat Expert you are accepting our rules regarding your personal information as described in this privacy policy.

If you are an End User of a game that includes Anti-Cheat Expert then we are not the data controller for your personal data, we are solely a data processor. For End Users, the specific data that we process is stipulated by the developer of the game (our Customer) who is the data controller, and the description of that data should be set out in the privacy policy for the relevant service or game.

Anti-Cheat Expert has been developed by Aceville Pte Ltd. (“we”, “us”, “our”). For the purpose of data protection laws, the data controller of your Customer personal information in relation to Anti-Cheat Expert is Aceville Pte Ltd. which is a Singapore based company within our corporate group. 1. The Types of Personal Information We Use

This section describes the different types of personal information we collect from you and how we collect it. If you would like to know more about specific types of data and how we use that data, please see the section entitled **[How we use your personal information]** below.

If you are an End User of a game that includes Anti-Cheat Expert then we are not the data controller for your personal data, we are solely a data processor.

The following is a high level summary of the types of personal information we use:

a. Information you provide to us (either directly or through a third party).

If you are a Customer, you give us information about you when you contact us and register for Anti-Cheat Expert. As part of the registration set up, we will collect your name, email address, country, password, mobile phone number (for verification purposes), and the gaming operator you are affiliated with.

b. Information generated as part of Anti Cheating Expert

We automatically collect certain data from you when you use of Anti Cheating Expert so that the many functions and services that comprise Anti-Cheat Expert can operate. This includes our Customer support feature which will collect your email address, content of your message, user account information and security related information which includes your name, email address, content of your message and account information. We will also collect your IP address, log-in history, account modification history and device information (ACE SDK).

We also collect and store your data:

- If you use or redeem any of the coupons on Anti-Cheating Expert, we will process your coupon code(s), and your redemption history.
- If you grant or edit access rights to others, we will process your user email and the permissions edit history.

2. Website Cookies

When you access the Anti-Cheating Expert website as a Customer, we use cookies and other similar technologies (e.g. web beacons, log files, scripts and eTags) (“**Cookies**”) to enhance your experience using the website. Cookies are small files which, when placed on your device, enable us to provide certain features and functionality.

You have the option to permit installation of such Cookies or subsequently disable them. You may accept all Cookies or refuse to accept all Cookies here. However, in the event of your refusal to install Cookies, our website may be unable to operate as designed.

3. Children

For End Users, the specific data that we process is stipulated by the developer of the game (our Customer) who is the data controller, and the description of that data should be set out in the privacy policy for the relevant service or game.

We may collect other personal information from time to time for specific reasons (such as a promotion in your country). When this happens, we will provide more information on any specific changes to the way we process that personal information that might differ to this privacy policy prior to collecting or processing any additional information. In some cases, that information may be shared with us with consent – and if that is the case, we will provide further information on how we process that information and any rights of individuals.

5. How We Store and Share Your Personal Information

Our group operates around the world. Pursuant to our contract with you to provide you Anti-Cheat Expert, your personal information will be processed on servers that may not be located where you live. Our servers for Anti-Cheat Expert are located in Singapore. In addition, our support, engineering and other teams are located in our offices around the world (including Singapore) and will have access to your information. No matter where our servers are located, we take appropriate measures to safeguard your rights in accordance with this privacy policy.

Only where necessary will we share your personal information with third parties. Situations where this occurs are:

- **Third parties** that provide services in support of Anti-Cheat Expert, including for the processing of customer support communications and providers of cloud services that process information identified in this policy on their servers for the purpose of providing Anti-Cheat Expert. All

companies providing Anti-Cheat Expert for us are prohibited from retaining, using, or disclosing your personal information for any purpose other than providing us with their services.

- **Companies within our corporate group** who process your personal information in order to operate Anti-Cheat Expert. All related group companies may only use your personal information in accordance with this privacy policy.
- **Regulators, judicial authorities, law enforcement agencies and other third parties for safety, security or compliance with law** . There are circumstances in which we are legally required to disclose information, such as to law enforcement agencies, public authorities or other organisations, or if we have a good faith belief that such use is reasonably necessary to:
 - comply with a legal obligation, process or request;
 - enforce our terms and conditions and other agreements, including investigation of any potential violation thereof;
 - detect, prevent or otherwise address security, fraud or technical issues; or
 - protect the rights, property or safety of us, our users, a third party or the public as required or permitted by law (exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction).
- **A third party that acquires all or substantially all of us or our business.** We may also disclose your information to third parties if we either: (a) sell, transfer, merge, consolidate or re-organise any part(s) of our business, or merge with, acquire or form a joint venture with, any other business, in which case we may disclose your data to any prospective buyer, new owner, or other third party involved in such change to our business; or (b) sell or transfer any of our assets, in which case the information we hold about you may be sold as part of those assets and may be transferred to any prospective buyer, new owner, or other third party involved in such sale or transfer.

6. Security of Personal Information

We are committed to maintaining the privacy and integrity of your personal information no matter where it is stored. We have information security and access policies that limit access to our systems and technology, and we protect data through the use of technological protection measures such as encryption.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will implement and maintain reasonable measures to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of the information transmitted to our services; therefore we do not assume any responsibility for any transmission of your information which you do at your own risk.

We may provide links to and from the websites and/or applications of our partners and affiliates. If you follow a link to any of these websites, please note that these websites and/or applications have their

own privacy policies and that we do not accept any responsibility or liability for these policies. Please check these policies before you submit any information to these websites and/or applications. Your acceptance or consent to this privacy policy does not cover your acceptance or consent to any other privacy policies.

7. Data Retention

We do not keep your data for longer than is necessary unless we are required to do so under law. For further details on how long we keep your data, please refer to the time periods set out below.

If we are required to retain your information beyond the retention periods set out above, for example to comply with applicable laws, we will store it separately from other types of personal information.

8. Your Rights

Some jurisdictions' laws grant specific rights to users of Anti-Cheat Expert, which are set out in this section.

This section entitled “Your Rights” applies to users that are located in the Relevant Jurisdictions. If you are located in a territory outside a Relevant Jurisdiction, please refer to the Supplemental Jurisdiction-Specific Terms for an overview of your rights and how these can be exercised.

The sub-sections entitled “Access”, “Correction”, and “Erasure” also apply to users that are located in Canada, Argentina, India, Russia and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

Access

You have the right to access personal information we hold about you, how we use it, and who we share it with. Portability

Correction

You have the right to correct any of your personal information we hold that is inaccurate. You can access the personal information we hold about you by logging into your Anti-Cheat Expert account. If you believe we hold any other personal information about you and that information is inaccurate, please contact us at dpo@anticheatexpert.com.

Erasure

You can delete your account, or remove certain personal information, by logging into your Anti-Cheat Expert account. If there is any other personal information you believe we process that you would like us to erase, please contact us at dpo@anticheatexpert.com.

We may need to retain personal information if there are valid grounds under data protection laws for us to do so (for example, for the defence of legal claims or freedom of expression) but we will let you know if that is the case. Where you have requested that we erase personal information that has been made available publicly on Anti-Cheat Expert and there are grounds for erasure, we will use reasonable steps to try to tell others that are displaying the personal information or providing links to the personal information to erase it too.

Restriction of Processing to Storage Only

You have a right to require us to stop processing the personal information we hold about you other than for storage purposes in certain circumstances. Please note, however, that if we stop processing the personal information, we may use it again if there are valid grounds under data protection laws for us to do so (for example, for the defence of legal claims or for another's protection). As above, where we agree to stop processing the personal information, we will try to tell any third party to whom we have disclosed the relevant personal information so that they can stop processing it too.

Objection

Announcements

We may from time to time send you announcements when we consider it necessary to do so (for example, when we temporarily suspend access to Anti-Cheat Expert for maintenance, or security,

privacy or administrative-related communications). You may not opt-out of these service-related announcements, which are not promotional in nature.
